



When you want to find the answer to a question, a good place to look is in a special book. There are many different kinds of such books – dictionaries, encyclopaedias ¹, atlases or telephone books. There is important information in these books. An encyclopaedia has information on people, places and ideas. A dictionary gives meanings of words, shows how people should pronounce them. An atlas has maps that show where places are situated. A telephone book gives names, addresses and telephone numbers of people and businesses. In each situation people will use different books. For example, if you want to know where lilies grow you will read an encyclopaedia, if you want to know what the words "lily" means you will use a dictionary.
